RR Bridge status: Bill figures there is about \$120K for dirt work. This figure includes surveying. He is waiting for a bid from Picker Munson, and Ralph Martinez. Jeff will call Picker and see if he can get the numbers. Bill says he would like to move the dirt and get it in place to show the public that we're doing something and that the project hasn't stalled. Also, The Town of Palmer Lake doesn't want to use shipping containers because they are esthetically unappealing. The town is will to front \$42,000 for the new design which would include an open structure all the way across from end to end. However the town wants to be paid back the fronted money. Darin will be going to the next town council meeting on August 8<sup>th</sup>, to give an update and also ask the town if it will consider just giving the money for the bridge without it having to be paid back.
