Town council is not happy with APL because they say there is no communication. Kathy says she has reported on our meetings every month. And before Kathy, we had Paul Banta reporting to the council. Mitch Davis is interested in being on the council and as well as Mark Schuler.

GOCO: We have filed our extension. Jane needs to talk to the people from GOCO who can talk to the RR.

Water in the Lake: Reservoir was full, but Steve O wants to make up 6" before he can release water. Mark Schuler has suggested a beach area for the lake. The committee isn't sure that would be a good idea.

Well monitoring: Kathy has asked Steve about the monitoring of the lake wells. He says he wants it to go through the town.

Basefield: Tri-Lakes little league is debating on whether or not to put in real grass or artificial turf. The town only has about 10 or 20 taps left, so that is a concern. Kathy will approach town council.

Moving of the Dirt: Kathy says Jason is ready to do this work but needs some direction. We need a general contractor to do this.

Glow Run: May 13<sup>th</sup>. Everything that glows will be there with the exception of face painting. There isn't any paint that's not toxic to the kids. There will be better lighting this year. Entry fee is \$25 dollars. Event Bright will be accessible to sign up.

Fireworks: Willing and ready to go. We're just waiting to see if we get enough rain to allow the fireworks to happen.
